

- SEAT IBIZA, SEAT IBIZA ST & SKODA FABIA HATCH & ESTATE:** Remove the rear light clusters.
- Remove the rear bumper.
- Remove the rear crash beam (This is not refitted with Towbar assembly).
- Locate Towbar mounting points on the outside face of each chassis member, these are usually covered in tape.
- Insert items **C** into each chassis member, choose correct hole location for vehicle, line up with Towbar mounting points in chassis members then loosely fix in place using item **F** and item **J** (**USING ITEM D ON FORWARD MOST MOUNTING POINT IF NEEDED**).
- Using item **F** and item **J** bolt item **A** between items **C**.
- Using item **H** with item **K** and item **G** bolt item **B** and item **E** to item **A**.
- Fully tighten all nuts and bolts ensuring the Towbar is rigid, square and secure.
- Cut the bumper to the correct sketch for your vehicle and refit.



**Note:**

- Recommended Torque Setting for M12 Grade 10.9 -139 Nm. (For other Torque Settings see notes overleaf.)
- Nose load limits and vehicle manufacturer's trailer / caravan weight limits must be observed.
